

Travel

By air

Stirling is close to two international airports: Edinburgh International Airport, and Glasgow International Airport. There is a regular bus service from Edinburgh International Airport to Edinburgh Waverley and Haymarket stations. There is a regular bus service from Glasgow International Airport to Glasgow Queen Street station.

By train

From Edinburgh, there are regular train services from Edinburgh Waverley and Haymarket stations to Stirling. From Glasgow, there are regular train services from Glasgow Queen Street station to Stirling. Those travelling by train should alight either at Stirling station, or at nearby Bridge of Allan station (the one just after Stirling). Those alighting at Stirling station should either take a taxi from outside the station, or a bus from nearby Murray Place. FirstBus operate the following services to the University - Unilink (UL), 53, 54, 58, 62 and 63. The journey from Stirling station to the University should take about ten minutes. Those alighting at Bridge of Allan station should be aware that no taxis or buses run from outside this station. There is about a twenty-five minute walk from this station to the University.

By car

From the East, South, or West take the M9 to Junction 11. Once at the junction there is a roundabout which marks the end of the M9. From here you should take the exit for Bridge of Allan, follow the road through the town itself, and after about 200 metres you will find the University entrance on the left.

From the North, take the A9 to the same roundabout and follow the same route as above through to Bridge of Allan.

Parking on campus

Delegates may park their cars in any of the designated car parking places on campus. No permit is necessary.
